Cooking Through the Calendar



Slow Cooker Chicken Sante Fe Soup



Ingredients:

- 4 thawed boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- 1 (7 ounce) can chopped green chilies
- 1 (8 ounce) bag frozen corn
- 1 (28 ounce) can diced tomatoes, no salt added
- 1 (15 ounce) can black beans
- 1 (14 ounce) can or box vegetable broth, no salt added
- 1 (32 ounce) box low-sodium chicken broth
- 3 tablespoons low sodium chili seasoning mix

Directions:

Place all ingredients in slow cooker and simmer on low 6-8 hours or 3-4 hours on high. Remove cooked chicken and shred with two forks.

Return chicken to soup and it is ready-to-serve.
